

# NH LAKES 2011 Lake Host™ Program – Training Requirements and Sessions

## 2011 LAKE HOST™ PROGRAM TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

The following participating individuals are required to attend a NH LAKES/DES formal training session:

- New Point Persons: required
- Returning Point Persons: required
- New paid Lake Hosts: required
- Returning paid Lake Hosts: optional
- New volunteer Lake Hosts: optional
- Returning volunteer Lake Hosts: optional

The following participants are required to attend a local training session given by the Point Person/Managing Lake Host:

- Returning paid Lake Hosts that do not attend a 2011 NH LAKES/DES formal training session
- Returning volunteer Lake Hosts that do not attend a 2011 NH LAKES/DES formal training session
- New volunteer Lake Hosts that do not attend a 2011 NH LAKES/DES formal training session

## 2011 LAKE HOST™ PROGRAM TRAINING SESSIONS

One joint **Point Person only** training will be hosted by NH LAKES at the NH LAKES Headquarters at the Pierce Manse in Concord on Wednesday, May 11, 6-8pm.

Driving directions to **NH LAKES at the Pierce Manse**, 14 Horseshoe Pond Lane, Concord, NH:

- I-93 to Exit 15W.
- Stay in the right hand lane and go through 1 set of lights (**do not turn right onto Commercial Street**).
- At the T-intersection, take a **very hard** right onto **North Main Street (do not proceed through the intersection onto Route 3 – if you get to the Fire Station on the right, you have gone too far...turn around and at the next intersection, turn left onto Horseshoe Pond Lane and follow to the last house on the left)**.
- Follow North Main Street to the end.
- At the T-intersection, turn left onto Horseshoe Pond Lane.
- The Pierce Manse is the white house/carriage house on the right with green shutters.
- Take the first driveway on the right and when the driveway splits, take the right hand fork.
- Park in the lot. If there is no space in the lot, there is an upper parking lot along the road.

Four joint **Point Person/Lake Host** training will be hosted by NH LAKES at DES in 2011

- Saturday, May 21, 1:00 – 3:00 p.m., NH DES, 29 Hazen Drive, Concord
- Wednesday, May 25, 6:00 – 8:00 p.m., NH DES, 29 Hazen Drive, Concord
- Wednesday, June 8, 6:00 – 8:00 p.m., NH DES, 29 Hazen Drive, Concord
- Saturday, June 18, 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 noon, NH DES, 29 Hazen Drive, Concord

**Registration:**

**Directions to NH Department of Environmental Services, 29 Hazen Drive, Concord (all trainings):**

- **From the South and West:**
  - Take I-93 north to Exit 14 turning right at intersection.
  - At third light (at top of hill) turn left onto Hazen Drive.
  - Turn left at sign for Health & Human Services.
  - Visitor Parking is available in front of building.
  - Enter at the main entrance by the flag pole.
- **From the North:**

- Take I-93 south to Exit 15E onto I-393.
  - Take Exit 2 and turn left at end of exit ramp (East Side Drive).
  - Stay to the right and turn right at light onto Hazen Drive.
  - Turn right at sign for Health & Human Services.
  - Visitor Parking is available in front of building. Enter at the main entrance by the flag pole.
- **From the East:**
    - Take Route 4 west to Concord (Route 4 becomes I-393 in Concord).
    - Take Exit 2 and turn left at end of exit ramp.
    - Stay to the right and turn right at second light onto Hazen Drive.
    - Turn right at sign for Health & Human Services.
    - Visitor Parking is available in front of building.
    - Enter at the main entrance by the flag pole.
